Sr. Mary Anne Basile (1965-1971)

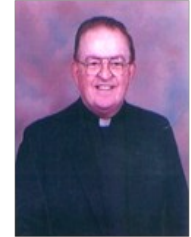
Former Maternity B.V.M. School Principal

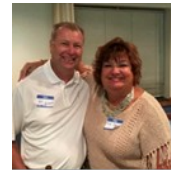
