

Summer Reading: Incoming 5th Grade: Choose ONE book.
Choices: From the Mixed-Up Files of Mrs. Basil E. Frankweiler by
E. L. Konigsburg OR Two-Minute Drill by Mike Lupica

****Part 1 and Part 2 will both be completed over the summer.**
Both parts are due September 14th or earlier.

Part 1: Choose 10 vocabulary words in the book that you DON'T know. Write a short definition and include a colored picture for each.

Part 2: Choose **one** activity.

This part can be done on a SMALL poster board (around 11" by 14"). Use a ruler to draw lines for your writing. Make your poster creative and colorful.

1. Create a new "cereal" based on the book. Draw and color a picture of your new cereal on the poster board. Write 6 sentences describing the cereal below the picture.
2. Create an advertisement giving at least 6 reasons explaining why someone should read this book. Add colored illustrations.
3. Create a "Top Six" list stating 6 lessons you learned by reading this book. Add colored illustrations.
4. Write a rhyming poem about the book (6-10 lines) Add colored illustrations
