Assignment: Cereal Box Book Report

- All pictures must be hand-drawn and categories should be hand-written. **NO TYPED COPIES OR PRINTED PICTURES.**

- On the front: **DRAW** a picture and give your “cereal” a name that reflects something important in the book—include the title of the book/author’s name/your name somewhere on the front.
- On the back: Write a summary of the book in your own words.
- On one side: Write the “ingredients”—the characters—and a sentence about each character.
- On the other side: Write 3-5 sentences describing the setting of the book.

Rubric/Grading:

- Directions: Are all requirements met?
 - Summary (30 pts.)
 - Characters/Descriptions (15 pts.)
 - Setting/Description (15 pts.)
 - Cereal Name (10 pts.)
- Effort: Grade-level effort of writing and artwork? (15 pts.)
- Language/Grammar/Spelling (15 pts.)
